Our Parish has been asked to consider hosting a children's choir from Paris, France this summer from July 11 - 15. They are coming to perform at churches in the Boston and Worcester area.

The choir director, Professor Francis Bardot, is a friend of Fr. Paul Tougas, who celebrates daily Mass at Our Lady of Fatima throughout the year. The French choir has been hosted by Fr. Paul and his former parish for the past 25 years. As a senior priest, Fr. Paul continues to support and be the liaison for this wonderful ministry and cultural exchange.

It will be a blessing and privilege to host this young group of choir members at Our Lady of Fatima. Their level of commitment and talent is truly inspiring!

Below are the additional details for their stay in Sudbury:

- The choir will arrive from Paris on July 11 and depart on July 15 (4 nights).
- There are 48 students travelling to the United States and they all speak English. Their ages range from 10-16 years old (Grades 4-10).
- 2 students will be assigned to each family (approximately 24 host families would be needed in total).

- Host families will provide lodging and meals for the students (meals as a group can also be arranged at Hurley Hall).
- The students will be with the choir during the day, practicing and going to other churches.
- Host families will not need to drive them to other churches or locations, only to and from Our Lady of Fatima.
- The choir director and pianist will be hosted by Fr. Paul Tougas.
- All host families need a 2017 CORI form, Protecting God's Children training and Code of Conduct, if not already completed.
